 SUBJECT: License Fees, Service Units and Product Updates

The Trns•port Task Force (TTF) is dedicated to keeping the Trns•port User Community abreast with the long range commitments and future direction of the Trns•port product line.

In a conscious effort to address the financial difficulties that many agencies are currently facing in this economic climate, the TTF has reviewed the current module licensing structure and has set licensing fees with this fact in mind.

The table below represents the licensing fees for the current fiscal year, FY2010, and next fiscal year, FY2011. The remaining columns are the maximum projected licensing fees for fiscal years 2012 through fiscal year 2015.

Additional changes are also being implemented in the Trns•port product licensing as follows: the Site License will now include the Civil Rights and Labor Management module (Trns•port CRLMS™). Furthermore, the licensing costs for Trns•port CRLMS and Trns•port Preconstruction® have decreased from their current fees acknowledging the expected lower support costs of web Trns•port versus client/server Trns•port modules.

Due to the major upcoming release of web Trns•port™ version 2.01 in December 2010, the TTF has decided to extend the two 'No Cost' implementation service units for Trns•port Preconstruction.

In order for an agency to take advantage of this offer, the agency would have until June 29, 2011 to:

1. Obtain a license version of the software and
2. Work under the Service Units should be underway or complete within the same 12 months.

This means that the last date that an agency will be able to secure these service units is June 29, 2011. All other requirements remain the same.

In order to qualify for these Service Units you will need to submit a letter to the AASHTO Project Manager, Tony Bianchi, requesting them and also be actively pursuing the production implementation of the Trns•port Preconstruction module.
